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God, Look! Summary

Scripture: Matthew 9:37 *"The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few."*

Topic: One-to-one evangelism

Performance time: 1 hour

Number of Players: 15-30 players (smaller casts double up on parts)

Objective: This "dream play" speaks to every person's search for significance. It follows the adventures of a new Christian, "*Lost*" who becomes "*Found*," then learns from her "*Teacher*," the importance of helping one "*Lost*" person at a time, become "*Found*." She stands in awe at the pure simplicity of God's high call to evangelism.

Synopsis:

"God, Look!" is the inspiring story of "Lost" who becomes "Found" when a "Teacher" shares the good news of the Gospel with her. Overwhelmed with the desire to please God, who did so much for her, our newly-found Christian begins her quest to discover what it is that pleases the heart of God the most.

Her *Teacher* leads *Found* on a journey and helps her understand the ever-increasing expressions of her faith. "Surely there could be nothing that pleases God more than this," she comments around each new turn in the road. She encounters the temptation of surrounding herself with the symbols of righteousness in "Outward Show"; with benevolent service in "The Body of Christ"; with a life of integrity in "Good Deeds," and finally, with an exuberant expression of her love and talent in "Public Ministry." Each time her patient teacher answers, "Yes, this pleases God, but there is more."

To *Found's* dismay, her teacher leads her right back to where he met her, only to discover another "*Lost*" soul. Surprised, "*Found*" cries out "I want to please God, not this man!" "*Teacher*" puts all our all our attempts at pleasing God into perspective as he calmly states, "How can you say you love God, whom you have not seen, if you do not love your brother whom you have seen? He challenges "*Found*" to become a teacher herself and begin the cycle again by helping this "*Lost*" one to become "*Found*."

"God, Look!" is a one hour, ensemble Christian play written to answer the question, "What is it that pleases God the most"? Few people ask themselves this question because the consumer mindset has left most Christians in the gentle "Comfort Zone" of the church pew where they are blissfully lulled into celestial fantasies as the organ melodiously pipes, "Nearer My God To Thee." They seem oblivious to the real issue: Christianity is a job description, not merely an affiliation!

This powerful message on personal evangelism is a one-hour Christian play the entire family will enjoy. "God, Look!" is excellent for Sunday mornings or evenings, mid-week Bible studies or a pot-luck dinner theater. It is excellent for retreats and touring companies as well.



Staging Overview




NOTE:

"God, Look!" is a surrealistic journey on which the new believer discovers how to please God. Because it is a "journey," "Teacher "and "Found" must travel. The performance space becomes their world, and the audience becomes their comrades as they discover the profound importance God places on all those who are "Lost" and the noble calling He extends to those who are "Found" to become "Teachers."

Therefore, configure this show to be a journey throughout your performance space. Where you place all of these scenes is your call; however, use the same playing spaces for different scenes. The actors come and go, using lights as their "curtain." Simply turn the light off on an area when a scene is finished, have the actors exit, have the next scene waiting to assume the same space, then turn the light on to indicate that we are in a new place at a new time.

This show is <u>very</u> set friendly. Simple props that require no backdrop are suggested: a table, a chair, a pot of flowers, etc. Place your singers on a platform, off to the side, but ideally: behind a screen or translucent curtain so their silhouettes can be seen as they sing. This show has an "Everyman" feel which takes place "Everywhere"! Have fun developing your own traffic pattern, just be sure that "Teacher and Found" establish some distance when they view scenes, and that "Teacher" is in the middle of the audience when he delivers his "Body of Christ" speech.






Make the mask using "plaster gauze" available at craft stores.


Form the mask with the eyeholes open. Make the eye covers separately.

Scene 1: "The Encounter"



NOTE:

Pre Show Curtain closed House is black The "Great Cloud of Witnesses" Singers sit behind a "scrim," or sheer curtain, for the entire show IN SILHOUETTE. **Backlight 1** should provide only a limited, "heavenly" backlight effect on the singers, hopefully enough to illuminate their sheet music so that music stand lights, which diminish the silhouette effect, are not needed. One of the seats near the center is to be left conspicuously empty in anticipation of TEACHER taking his place there during the Finale. Another one or two random seats may be left empty for added significance.

• MUSIC TRACK #1: "Overture"

Curtain opens as music begins.

LIGHT up Backlight 1 – 30% for entire show

LIGHT up Pool 3

A cool pool of LIGHT SLOWLY FADES UP on LOST as she crouches center stage in a fetal position. She takes a few desperate glances around, then quickly recoils. She wears a hideous mask with eyes pointed in opposite directions. EERIE MUSIC CUES up slowly as the lights come up. A mood of isolation and hopelessness prevails. TEACHER approaches LOST cautiously. MUSIC FADES into background sound.

THEME SEGUES FROM "LOOK AT ME" INTO "AMAZING GRACE"

I ONCE WAS LOST.

CHOIR:

MUSIC ENDS

TEACHER: Hello.

(LOST ignores him. TEACHER approaches even closer)

TEACHER: Are you Lost?

(LOST growls and tries to scare the teacher. TEACHER continues his approach as LOST tries to frighten him.

TEACHER: You don't scare me with that face.

(LOST makes a few more stalking moves toward Teacher.)

(Kneeling beside Lost) I have been sent to find you.

- LOST: (*Puzzled*) Find me? Why?
- **TEACHER**: Because your name is Lost.
- LOST: (Staring at her name bib from behind her hideous mask) You're right. I am Lost; I have always been l lost.

TEACHER: I have been sent to find you by one who loves you.

(LOST recoils at the word, "love," but TEACHER comes even closer.)

TEACHER: There is one who loves you.

LOST: No one *loves me. (* = *start music*)

• MUSIC TRACK #2 – D/U (music sneaks in down/underneath dialogue): "Jesus Loves Me"

LIGHT up slowly Pool 6 – 25%

TEACHER: Oh yes, let me help you see the love God has for you.

(TEACHER reaches out to adjust the mask. LOST pulls away quickly.)

TEACHER: What is it?

LOST: No one has ever touched me.

TEACHER: I will. I'm not *afraid.

• MUSIC TRACK #3 – D/U: "They Are Weak"

I've come to tell you that you are the most glorious of all God's creations. You are beautiful to Him

LOST:	I am <u>not</u> beautiful!			
(LOST lunges	(LOST lunges toward him to show him her face, up close.)			
TEACHER:	<i>(taking an objective look)</i> That's not the "real you." That's just a mask, and you're hiding behind it. The longer you wear it, the uglier it gets.			
LOST:	(interrupting him) See, you said I'm ugly.			
TEACHER:	The mask is ugly; you're beautiful, but you have to take the mask *off!			

• MUSIC TRACK #4 – D/U: "Striving"

Are you willing to strip off that false front and find the beauty underneath?

LOST: Will it hurt?
TEACHER: Yes, but I will be with you; I'll help you do it.
LOST: (turning away) No. Leave me alone. I cannot be loved. (glaring at him again) This is who I really am!
TEACHER: No! Your beauty is hidden under layers of sin. (she recoils) Sin has stolen the radiant beauty God made you to be, And now you hide under there, all alone; it's too heavy for you; take it off!
(LOST moves away; TEACHER follows her.)

I have been sent to tear away this ugly mask by one who takes away the ugliness of the whole world. Let me teach you about him.

LOST:	(Turning toward Teacher) The whole world?
TEACHER:	<i>(Stepping toward LOST, who recoils)</i> Yes, but you must let me touch you, or I cannot teach you.
LOST:	Who is this one who can take away this ugliness? <i>(pointing to her mask.)</i> What is his *name?

• MUSIC TRACK #5: "His Name is Wonderful"

(TEACHER approaches LOST and begins to remove the mask piece by piece during the following passages:)

TEACHER: His name is Wonderful Counselor,

☺ SINGERS: HIS NAME IS WONDERFUL,

LIGHT up Pool 6 – 50%

Mighty God, (*He tears off a piece of the mask.*)

☺ SINGERS: HIS NAME IS WONDERFUL,

LIGHT up Pool 6 – 75%

Eternal Father, (*He tears off another piece of the mask.*)

☺ SINGERS: HIS NAME IS WONDERFUL,

LIGHT up Pool 6 – 100%

Prince of Peace. (*He unties the strings and removes the mask.*)

☺ SINGERS: JESUS MY LORD.

He is the Lamb of God, sent to take away the sins of the world.

LOST: The sins?

TEACHER: Yes, it is your sins that create this mask.

(TEACHER picks up pieces of the mask and holds it up for LOST to see.)

and hide who you were meant to be.

We all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

LOST: You too?

TEACHER: Me *too.

• MUSIC TRACK #6: "Shepherd"

	All of us like sheep have gone astray, but the Lord has placed on Him, the iniquity of us all.
LOST:	On who?
TEACHER:	On Jesus, the Son of God. <i>(She looks confused)</i> The free gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ, our Lord.
LOST:	How?
TEACHER:	He bore the shame this mask brings. He died under the weight of it; Then tore it off and rose to life again. He lives to remove this mask from as many as receive Him; to them, He gives the right to become children of God; even to those who believe in His name.

• MUSIC TRACK #7: "He's the Great Shepherd"

(While the SINGERS sing, TEACHER continues explaining to FOUND in mime.)

LIGHT down Pool 6 – fade to 25 %

 SINGERS:
 HE'S THE GREAT SHEPHERD, THE ROCK OF ALL AGES, ALMIGHTY GOD IS HE.
 HIS NAME IS WONDERFUL, HIS NAME IS WONDERFUL, HIS NAME IS WONDERFUL, JESUS, MY LORD.

LIGHT up Pool 6 – 100 %

LOST: I believe in His name.

(TEACHER takes LOST by the hand and lifts her to her feet. The COOL LIGHT is replaced by a warm glow on stage. LOST sees the pieces of the mask lying in a heap as rubbish at her feet.)

TEACHER: Whoever calls upon the name of the Lord shall be *saved!

• MUSIC TRACK #8 – D/U: "Was Blind, But Now I See"

LOST:	(LOST stares in amazement at the mask.) I have never seen this before.
TEACHER:	Of course not, because the darkness of your sin has blinded your eyes.
LOST:	I was *blind?

• MUSIC TRACK ##9: "Consecrated"

TEACHER: But now you see!

(TEACHER takes the washcloth and wash basin that are hidden in the plants on the edge of the DC stage. He dips the washcloth into the water in the wash basin and begins to wash LOST's face. The sound of splashing and the image of rinsing continues for the next few passages:)

© SINGERS: TAKE MY LIFE AND LET IT BE. CONSECRATED LORD, TO THEE.

LOST:Why do you wash my face?TEACHER:Unless you are born of water and the Spirit, you shall
not enter the kingdom of God.LOST:(She takes the washcloth from TEACHER and begins to
wash her whole body.) Then not just my face, but all of
me.

• MUSIC TRACK #10: "Hands"

© SINGERS:

TAKE MY HANDS AND LET THEM MOVE AT THE IMPULSE OF THY LOVE, AT THE IMPULSE OF ... THY ... LOVE.

TEACHER: (symbolically baptizing LOST)

FOUND: Let me be *born!

• MUSIC TRACK #11: "Now I See"

© SINGERS: I ONCE WAS LOST, BUT NOW AM FOUND, WAS BLIND, BUT NOW I SEE.

(LOST takes the washcloth and begins to wash her arms, legs, and hands enthusiastically. TEACHER reaches for her name bib and turns it around to read: FOUND.)

FOUND: What are you doing with my name?

TEACHER: You were Lost, but now you are found.

FOUND: I have a new *name?

• MUSIC TRACK #12: "Nothing But The Blood"

TEACHER:	(turning around to look at Found)
	What is keeping you?

FOUND: I'm coming; I just have to get up here.

(FOUND approaches TEACHER. She is trying to keep her balance up on the stilts. She is a bit winded but intends to stay on them.)

- **TEACHER**: Why do you walk on those?
- **FOUND:** I have always walked on these. I can see better from up here.
- TEACHER: Get down.
- FOUND: I can't do that. If I get down, nobody will see me.
- **TEACHER:** Get down!
- **FOUND:** I will get lost again if I get down *there.

• MUSIC TRACK #13: "I'd Rather Have Jesus"

TEACHER: You are no longer lost, you are found. Now get down! **FOUND:** But I must stay above the others!

TEACHER: Then, you cannot learn from me.

(TEACHER turns his back and walks back DR. She panics when she sees him leaving; she follows him the best she can on those cumbersome stilts.)

SINGERS: I'D RATHER HAVE JESUS THAN SILVER OR GOLD, I'D RATHER BE HIS THAN HAVE RICHES UNTOLD ...

FOUND: But I want to learn.

TEACHER: *(Approaching her sternly)* Then humble yourself. Get down from your selfimportance, and walk with me.

FOUND: I will have to learn to walk all over again!

TEACHER: I will walk beside you.

FOUND: Do you promise to hold me up?

TEACHER: One who is greater than I will hold us both up.

(TEACHER helps her off her stilts. FOUND reluctantly puts them down on the ground.)

FOUND: Really! *Who?

• MUSIC TRACK #14: "I'd Rather Have Jesus – Cause"

TEACHER: The eyes of the Lord move throughout the earth, so that He may truly support those whose hearts are completely His.

FOUND: Good! Then, we have nothing to fear.

(FOUND boldly takes off in the direction of DR, but is stopped by TEACHER who cautions her:)

TEACHER: Ah, be on the alert! Our adversary, the devil, prowls about like a roaring lion; seeking someone to devour!

• MUSIC TRACK #15: "Sin's Dread Sway"

FOUND:Oh no! (hiding behind teacher)We must not go on then; what if he finds us?

© SINGERS: ... OR BE HELD IN SIN'S DREAD SWAY.

TEACHER: Greater is He that is in us, than he that is in the world.

LIGHT up Pool 8

LIGHT Pools 3, 6 up 100%

(TEACHER and FOUND walk off DR together. They take a step down the stairs into the audience. FOUND is now clearly lower than she was to begin with.)

FOUND:I can't see a thing from down here,
and I'm sure nobody will notice me either!
(She turns to walk back on stage.)
Let me go back and walk the way I've always walked!

TEACHER: *(following her back in the direction of DC) Wait*! Before we go any further, you must learn this first lesson, or you will be of little use in the kingdom of God.

FOUND: Can I get my stilts first? I'll be able to see you better.

(FOUND picks up the stilts and tries to get up on them again. TEACHER takes them from her and throws them down.)

TEACHER: No! You may never again elevate yourself over others! In the family of God, you may do nothing out of selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind, regard others as more important than yourself. Have this attitude in yourself, which was also in Christ Jesus, our Lord.

(FOUND picks up the stilts and pouts.)

FOUND: Then no one will notice me!

• MUSIC TRACK #16: "Applause or Dominion"

*Even if all the world ignores you, God will see your every move! Even the hairs on your head are numbered.



(DADDY is seated, reading his paper after a hard day at work. MOMMY is occupied with some needle work. Between then, seated at their feet is their LITTLE GIRL. She is actively playing with a little shoebox, pretending it is a cradle.)

GIRL: Daddy, look. See the dolly bed I made?
DADDY: (glancing over his newspaper) That's very nice, honey!
(DADDY continues reading his paper so the LITTLE GIRL's attention shifts to MOMMY. The dolly bed is shoved right up into MOMMY's face.)

GIRL:	Mommy, Look. It's a really nice bed, huh?
MOMMY:	Oh, yes. It's a wonderful little bed.
GIRL:	Did you see it?

MOMMY:	Ves dear	I saw it up close!
	res, dear.	I saw it up close!

- GIRL: I'm gonna draw decorations on it now just like a real baby bed, OK?
- **MOMMY:** OK, That's a great idea.

(The LITTLE GIRL settles down and draws a few designs on the dolly bed. She jumps up to show her DADDY and startles him so both he and his newspaper jump up a bit.)

- **GIRL**: Daddy, Look! I drew a picture of you and me and Mommy on the side of the cradle. Isn't it cute! **DADDY:** That's very pretty, honey. You're a good artist. (She climbs up on DADDY's lap and crumples his newspaper.) **GIRL**: Would you like to tell me a story, now? **DADDY:** I just got home, sweetie. Would you let me relax just a little while, then I will, OK? **GIRL**: (reluctantly she gets down) OK.
 - I'll make something else out of my *box.

• MUSIC TRACK #18: "Attention Theme"

(She lays on her tummy, kicking her feet, as she draws windows on the box and turns it into a van. She sits up and again, she boldly shows it to MOMMY.)

GIRL: Mommy, Look! I made a van with pictures of people on the inside. See, this is us, and we're going on vacation.

(MOMMY nods but seems disinterested. The little GIRL gets irritated at being ignored.)

Mommy, Look!

MOMMY: Very nice!

GIRL: (*Shifting over to her father, who is*

trying to read.) Daddy, Look! We're going on vacation in the van I made, see! Daddy, Look!

(She uses DADDY's legs as roads for her van. He peaks up over the newspaper again, reaches down to stop her, and crumples the paper in his lap.)

DADDY:	You know, there are a whole bunch of hills in the back yard. Why don't you take your little family on vacation out there?
GIRL:	No! I want to stay in here with you.
DADDY:	Well, there's not much for the family to see on their vacation if you stay in here!
(He hides beh	ind his newspaper again.)
GIRL:	Well, OK. I'll go outside. Then, I'll come right back in and be with you.
DADDY:	(looking over his newspaper and seeing her face-to-face.) * Good!

• MUSIC TRACK #19: "Just Like You"

LIGHT Pool 7 stays Up

LIGHT up Pool 9 – 50%

(The LITTLE GIRL reluctantly goes outside by stepping down DL. DADDY watches her leave. She sits down and begins playing with her toy box in view of the audience. When she is clearly gone, he puts down his paper. He turns to MOMMY in desperation.)

- **DADDY:** Why does she do that?
- **MOMMY:** Do what?
- DADDY: Every time I turn around, it's "Daddy, Look"! Is she like that with you all day long? Is it "Mommy, look, I ate my Jello"! "Mommy, Look! I'm breathing"! "Mommy, Look! My hair is growing"!

MOMMY:	Yes.
DADDY:	Doesn't it ever drive you crazy?
MOMMY:	Yes, but you have to understand why she does it.
DADDY:	Why?
MOMMY:	The most important thing in the world for her is impressing you. She'll do anything to get your attention.
DADDY:	(concerned) Is that good?
MOMMY:	That's natural. She would be a bad child if she didn't care to please us. Only a spoiled child would take what she wants and ignore her parents. Be grateful she wants to give you the only thing she has to give:

(DADDY leans in, as if to ask "What?")

... *herself!

• MUSIC TRACK #20: "See What I Can Do"

LIGHT up Pool 9 – 100% LIGHT Pool 7 fade to 50%

LITTLE GIRL'S SOLO:

LOOK AT ME! SEE WHAT I CAN DO? DADDY LOOK! AM I PLEASING YOU? THERE'S A YEARNING INSIDE THAT WON'T BE SATISFIED TILL I'M ALL THAT YOU WANT ME TO BE.

LIGHT Pool 9 fade to Black LIGHT up Pool 7 – 100%

(DADDY sits again after taking all this in, and thoughtfully replies:)

DADDY: I guess, when you put it that way, I'm glad she plays "Daddy, Look!" every time I turn around.

MOMMY: I think you'd be pretty disappointed if she didn't.

(The LITTLE GIRL enters the room excitedly. She carries a can of black spray paint in her hands. She runs over to Daddy and grabs his hand, pulling him toward the door.)

GIRL: Daddy, Look! I tinted the windows on your *car

LIGHT Pool 7 fade to Black LIGHT up Pool 8

• MUSIC TRACK #21: "Look At Me - Tag"

(DADDY reacts with a shock, and MOMMY bursts out laughing. LIGHTS BLACK ON DL and LIGHTS UP ON DR with Teacher and Found.)FOUND: I played "Daddy, Look" and "Mommy,

- Look" all the time!
- TEACHER: Well, now it's time to play, "God, Look!"
- **FOUND:** What?
- **TEACHER** You don't have to run around shouting "God, look!" every time you do something to please Him, but in your heart, you are trying to please Him the same way a good child tries to please the parents he loves.
- **FOUND:** I want to be a good child.
- **TEACHER:** Not one who is spoiled by getting, and unable to give in return. We are children of the king, and to be noticed by Him is the highest glory we will ever know.
- **FOUND:** But you just said we must not want glory, you made me get down off my stilts, and you said...
- **TEACHER**: That's because you were seeking the Glory that the world has to give. That is only vain and passing, but glory, honor, and peace, are given to those who please the *Lord.

• MUSIC TRACK #22: "What God Thinks"

(FOUND takes a few steps away from teacher and thoughtfully replies)

FOUND: You know something?

TEACHER: What?

FOUND: I used to spend hours trying to decide what I thought of God, but now I see that the important thing is what God thinks of me!

FOUND: Will you teach me?
TEACHER: How to love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your *mind?

• MUSIC TRACK #23: "Found and Girl Duet"

FOUND: Will that please Him?
TEACHER: Very much!
FOUND: (Singing)
LOOK AT ME, I'M MORE GROWN UP NOW. LET ME TRY; WON'T YOU SHOW ME HOW.

(The LITTLE GIRL, holding her paint can, joins FOUND in singing this last stanza of the song; her DADDY watches her intently in the shadow as the light spills over into the area where he was reading his paper.)



Platform in Audience

LIGHT Pool 8 stays up LIGHT up Pools 9, 10 and Full House

(Festive carnival music is played throughout the "outward show" scene. It changes from up and lively, to down and under during the conversations.

TEACHER and FOUND walk toward the center as the vendors take their places. They watch as the first two give their sales pitches. FOUND is amazed at the glamour of it all.

Each vendor carries the items of his trade in a tray suspended from his neck with a cord, and resting on his tummy, like popcorn vendors at a ball game. The vendors are spread out throughout the audience and use the audience members as perspective customers as they try to sell their wares to them.)

- **T-SHIRT:** (selecting an audience member) Sir, you look like a large to me. Do you have one of these "Jesus saves" T-shirts? I'll bet you thought He only saved people, get it? Jesus saves T-shirts, Ha. Ha... **JEWELRY:** *(selecting another audience member)* We have the "descending dove" necklace, and matching dove earrings for only \$29.95. With this week's bracelet bonus added at a mere \$12.95, that brings our total to a modest \$42.90. (FOUND turns to TEACHER in her wide-eyed wonder and asks,) FOUND: What's this? **TEACHER:** It's a new show in town. It's called Outward. FOUND: Outward?
 - TEACHER: Yes, outward show.
 - **FOUND:** Does it please God?
 - **TEACHER:** Well, let me put it this way: These are the symbols of righteousness.
 - **FOUND**: Can they please God?
 - **TEACHER:** Yes, they can, but there is so much *more than just....

• MUSIC TRACK #25: "Calliope"

SINGERS D/U:

(CALLIOPE THEME) **BOOP, BOOP, BOOP-BOO-DOOP, etc.**

(TEACHER is interrupted by a charging FOUND who approaches the BUMPER-STICKER SALESPERSON.)

BUMPER-STICKER: (*reading whatever stickers he can find*) Let those drivers know that you drive a spirit-filled car ladies and gentlemen. Witness on the freeway! Only one dollar each, hurry, hurry.

FOUND: (reaching for her dollar and handing it to him) I'll take one. (glancing back at Teacher) Teacher, Look! I have a bumper sticker!

(TEACHER's eyes look up to the ceiling; FOUND looks up to and proudly holds her bumper-sticker up for God to see.)

FOUND: God, look! I have a bumper-sticker!

(FOUND is distracted by the screams of the magazine salesperson.)

SINGERS: (PUNCHLINE THEME) BEEM, BAHM, BOHM BOHM, BOHM-BOHM ... BOOM!

MAGAZINE: Round out your workday, folks, with some relaxing religious reading. We have our magazine of the month club. Just sign up today for the magazine of your choice, and one additional magazine will be sent to you each month. No payments for twelve months. *(holding up various magazines)*

> Religion and You, Pearls for the Pulpit, Lovely Christian Lady

FOUND: I'd like a magazine, please.

MAGAZINE: Hello there, you look like the type who would like a copy of <u>Lovely Christian Lady.</u> Here you go! *(He hands her the magazine.)* And, I have some books here that might interest you.

• MUSIC TRACK #26: "Circus"

SINGERS: (CIRCUS THEME) BAOM, (BAOM), BAOM, (BAOM), BAOM, (BAOM-BAOM) BAOM, (BAOM), BAOM, (BAOM), BAOM, (BAOM-BAOM) BAOM, (BAOM), BAOM, (BAOM), BAOM, (BAOM-BAOM) BOW - - - WOP! BOP!

(During "Chorus Theme" music, the MAGAZINE SALESPERSON stacks book after book into FOUND's waiting hands. He finds the one he's after and declares:)

MAGAZINE: Oh, here's one, <u>Submission Made Easy</u>. Just the book for you, my dear. FOUND:(exchanging her stack of books for this one)
Oh, thank you.
Will you take a check?

MAGAZINE: Check, money order, VISA, Master Card, American Express, or just plain cash. Money is money; it makes the world go 'round, *ya know!

• MUSIC TRACK #27: "Punchline"

SINGERS: (PUNCHLINE THEME) BEEM, BAHM, BOHM, BOHM, BOHM-BOHM ... BOOM!

> (FOUND quickly writes the check and notices the BIBLE COVER SALESPERSON who comes over to her as she walks up the aisle.)

BIBLE COVER: Here's a blue one to match your lovely eyes, Miss. Look, it's complete with frills. It has a lovely cross in the center so everyone will know that you love Jesus.

FOUND is attracted by the words, "love Jesus" so she stops to examine the goods.

BIBLE COVER: You do want everyone to know that you love Jesus, don't you?

FOUND: Oh yes!

BIBLE COVER: Isn't it lovely!

FOUND: (looking up) God, look! It's got a cross on it! (back to the vendor) I must have this!

(FOUND writes another check, The MUSIC swells, and she takes the goods back to TEACHER, who has been pensively watching the entire scene from DR, halfway in the audience. FOUND runs up to him, heavily laden with her Christian stuff. The VENDORS leave, and the audience focuses on the platform out in the house, where FOUND is showing off her new stuff.)

LIGHT out in House

LIGHT out Pools 8, 9 LIGHT Pool 10 Stays 100%

FOUND: Teacher, Look! Look at everything I *bought.

• MUSIC TRACK #28: "Short Punchline"

I can hang this in my room, and look at this book, and I bought this purse.

TEACHER:	(after examining the Bible cover she hands him.) This isn't a purse.
FOUND:	It's not? Well, then what is it?
TEACHER:	It's a Bible cover.
FOUND:	A Bible cover! Oh, I don't have a Bible to cover. They weren't selling those.
TEACHER:	They often *don't.

• MUSIC TRACK #29: "Stinger"

(TEACHER reaches to pick up the Bible from underneath one of the two chairs on the platform placed out in the audience.)

and	Here, I have one for you, but it isn't like your other Christian stuff. This is the word of God that reveals His will for you. It is alive and sharp, live by it, let it pierce your soul.
FOUND:	<i>(She examines the Bible he hands her)</i> Will it show me how to please God?
TEACHER:	Oh yes, very clearly.
FOUND:	(Looking up) God, look! I have a Bible.

• MUSIC TRACK #30: "Short Punchline"




(TEACHER walks out into the audience and talks with FOUND who follows him.)

FOUND: What's the matter? Don't you like the things I bought? Don't they please God? **TEACHER:** Yes, I suppose it pleases God to surround ourselves with the things that remind us of Him but be careful with these things. FOUND: Why? **TEACHER:** They are dangerous. FOUND: Why? **TEACHER:** It is easy to let that be all because they cost us very little. FOUND: Oh, you're wrong there! This Bible cover cost \$25.00! **TEACHER:** That's not what I mean! FOUND: Then say what you mean! **TEACHER:** Beware of practicing your righteousness before men to be noticed by them; otherwise, you have no reward with your Father who is in Heaven. FOUND: (dejected) Then these things don't please God? **TEACHER:** They might, in the slightest bit, but there is so much more! (TEACHER points to the stage.)

Scene 5: "The Body"





LIGHT Pool 10 Stays 100% LIGHT up Pool 5

(An OLD WOMAN sits at stage right. LIGHTS come up on her. FOUND notices her and asks TEACHER about her.)

FOUND: Who's that?

TEACHER: An old woman.

• MUSIC TRACK #31: "The Body - Intro"

FOUND: *(slightly insulted) I* know that.

TEACHER:	Then why did you ask?	
FOUND:	What I meant was, why is she sitting there so sad and lonely?	
TEACHER:	Then say what you mean.	
FOUND:	(obviously flustered.) Well, okay, I just wonder	
TEACHER:	Ask with your heart, not your head; don't wonder, feel.	
FOUND:	She <i>(staring at her.)</i> She looks so miserable. What's wrong with her?	
TEACHER:	She is made in the image of God. His deepest need is hers also.	
FOUND:	I don't understand.	
TEACHER:	"For His pleasure we are created;" for fellowship, for love. Should it surprise you that she cannot exist without the arms of fellowship wrapped around her?	
FOUND:	God loves her; she can be happy about that, but God can't wrap His arms around her. Too bad God doesn't have a body.	

TEACHER: Oh, but He does.

FOUND: He does? *Where?

• MUSIC TRACK #32: "The Body"

TEACHER: (*Pointing out at the rest of the audience.*) All around us.

(TEACHER turns around slowly as he delivers this speech until he takes in the entire audience.)

MUSIC SWELLS AS CUE TO PROCEED

This is the body of Christ. We are one body and one spirit. To each one of us grace was given. He gave some as apostles, and some as prophets, some as evangelists, and some as pastors and teachers for the equipping of the saints for the work of service, to the building up of the body of Christ.

- FOUND:Then I'll go see her. I'll let God use the arms in my
body...(pausing to look at her own arms.)
I mean, His body. Will that please God?
- **TEACHER:** Pure and undefiled religion is to visit the widows and the orphans in their affliction. Do not grow weary in doing good, FOUND, for in due time you will reap your reward.

• MUSIC TRACK #33: "War Medley"

(FOUND runs to the front of the stage, grabs a basket of flowers on the way. Hands it to the woman and hugs her tightly. In due time the woman perks up, they chat in silent mime.)

© SINGERS: TAKE MY LIFE AND LET IT BE CONSECRATED LORD TO THEE TAKE MY HANDS AND LET THEM MOVE AT THE IMPULSE OF THY LOVE, AT THE IMPULSE OF ... THY ... LOVE.

(FOUND's attention is taken by the STARVING MAN at center stage.)

LIGHT up Pool 3

LIGHT Pool 10 Stays 100%

(A STARVING MAN lies helpless on the floor. Another person, wearing a T-shirt with a Christian Fish on the back of it, is unloading a food truck. The packages of food are unloaded just out of the STARVING MAN'S reach. FOUND looks on in wonder and approaches the STARVING MAN. LIGHTS FADE on the woman and come up on the STARVING MAN.)

FEMALE SINGERS: MALE SINGERS:

ONWARD CHIRSTIAN SOLDIERS, MARCHING AS TO WAR ...

INST. MUSIC D/U

FOUND: Teacher, who is that man?

TEACHER: Is that what you mean to ask?

FOUND: Yes...I mean, no. Why is he so weak?

TEACHER: He needs food.

LIGHT Pool 5 fade to Black

(FOUND walks over to get a better look at the STARVING MAN.)

FOUND: The food is right there. It's even Christian food. Why doesn't he get it?

TEACHER: Because parts of the body are missing. This man,

(TEACHER points to the man who has unloaded the food and who now stands frozen beside the STARVING MAN.)

has taken it as far as he can. Someone else must continue where he left off.

FOUND: *(Marching over to the starving man and staring out into the audience.)* Well for goodness sakes! There's plenty of people in the body, Teacher. Why doesn't someone just fill in and...

TEACHER: Someone just did. (motioning to her)

INSTR. MUSIC:

"... see His banners go." (Modulation)

INSTR. MUSIC D/U

LIGHT up Pool 7 LIGHT Pool 10 Stays 100%

(The man who delivered the food leaves, and FOUND continues to give food to the needy man. Her attention is taken away by two CHILDREN who are throwing paper wads and hitting each other at STAGE LEFT as the LIGHTS FADE UP on them.)

- FOUND: Who are...I mean, why are these children fighting?
- **TEACHER:** There is no one to teach them.
- **FOUND:** No one! Come on! This room is full of people, surely someone will....

LIGHT Pool 3 fade to Black

(FOUND gets up from helping the STARVING MAN and walks over to help the CHILDREN make peace.)

TEACHER: ... not hinder the children from coming to Him?

FOUND: Does it please God to teach the children?

TEACHER: Whoever welcomes one of these little ones, welcomes Him.

(FOUND awkwardly steps between the hostile pair. LIGHTS FADE OUT on the STARVING MAN. They stop fighting and talk with her. She cautiously holds their hands and talks with them in silent mime. Soon they appear to be laughing and smiling.

What follows is a light show: FOUND is no sooner occupied with the CHILDREN, than the light comes up on the STARVING MAN who groans for attention. FOUND runs over to him as the LIGHT GOES OFF on the CHILDREN. No sooner has she fed him, than the LIGHT COMES UP on the OLD WOMAN who reaches out for her. FOUND hurries over to the OLD WOMAN and hugs her. FOUND runs frantically from light pool to light pool ministering to each needy person in turn. This goes on for a while as the lights rotate faster and faster. The song of the Choir adds to the drama of the scene.)

LIGHTS alternate between Pools 5, 6, 7, Leave up Pool 10

Alternate slowly at first, then speed up across pools following and pushing "FOUND."

(TEACHER takes FOUND by the hand and leads her out to the the audience platform.)

LIGHT up Pool 10 LIGHT Pool 8 Fade to Black

TEACHER: There's more.





MARIBELL is entering the room, sorting the mail. TEACHER claps his hands once and the scene comes to life, FULL LIGHT ON DR.)

MARIBELL:	(casually entering as she reads the mail. She gasps as she reads the church paper, and speaks to herself.)	
	Amanda Montgomery appointed missions Chairman! Sister, look!	
ELIZABETH:	(Hardly looking up from her work)	

	What is it dear? More bills that I can deduct from this year's income! Oh, Maribell, I don't know why I have to figure our taxes, each year.
	You know I don't have a head for numbers. (She tosses a few receipts up casually)
MARIBELL:	Look!

(MARIBELL holds the paper up for ELIZABETH to read. ELIZABETH's face reveals her shock as she reads about Amanda.)

ELIZABETH:	No! Not Amanda Montgomery! Why land sakes, how could anyone ever give that woman such a position of responsibility?
MARIBELL:	Why, I don't know. Don't forget to claim Papa as a deduction, sister. <i>(She points to a column.)</i> Right here. We're sole support of an aging parent.
ELIZABETH:	<i>(writing in the information)</i> How old would our dear Papa be if he were still with us, Maribell?
MARIBELL:	Let's see, (<i>She fans herself with the paper.</i>) I believe he would be one hundred and eight years old this November!

(*The two women stare at each other and exchange a brief glance reflecting the slightest hint of guilt.*)

ELIZABETH:	Maribell, are sure the Internal Revenue Service won't find out about
MARIBELL:	Papa? Don't be silly, those people at the "infernal" revenue are way too busy to fret over us!
ELIZABETH:	<i>(grabbing the church paper from Maribell)</i> Pick a number for this year's charitable contributions, sister. It will take your mind off this frightful disgrace!
MARIBELL:	<i>(thinking it over)</i> Ah, how about \$780.00 to the United Way?

ELIZABETH: We should have receipts for that?

(MARIBELL gives ELIZABETH an incredulous look!)

MARIBEL: Oh, that's right, receipts. In that case, tell them we gave it to transients. They don't give receipts.

(MARIBELL takes the church paper from ELIZABETH again as ELIZABETH writes down the charitable contribution. She leans over to ELIZABETH secretly and whispers:)

MARIBELL: Does anyone know the truth about this woman?

ELIZABETH:	<i>(while writing in the figures)</i> Seven hundred and eighty. I should hope so. The woman has no principles.
MARIBELL:	Do the elders know she has served time in prison?

ELIZABETH: For perjury! Sign here, sister.

(MARIBELL takes the pen that ELIZABETH hands her but looks at her with a puzzled expression.)

ELIZABETH:	Sign it right here, dear.
MARIBELL:	Isn't this where you sign?
ELIZABETH:	We're filing joint! (after Elizabeth signs) How long was she in the joint?
MARIBELL:	The what?
ELIZABETH:	In jail, how long was Amanda in jail?
MARIBELL:	Oh, two years. She swore an oath in a court of law and lied. Can you imagine that sister?
	(leaning conspicuously over to Elizabeth)
	And what about her other problem? You know

ELIZABETH:	(while signing the return) Her drinking?
MARIBELL:	Yes, someone should alert the elders!
ELIZABETH:	I've heard she went to one of those programs, you know, to help her quit, but the woman simply has no sense of personal Christian propriety! <i>(She stuffs the returns into an</i> <i>envelope.)</i>
MARIBELL:	(Elizabeth hands the envelope to Maribell to lick and seal.) I've never seen her at the Ladies Home Aid Society.
ELIZABETH:	<i>(pointing to the time on the church paper.)</i> Of course not, it meets in the afternoon and you know what condition she's usually by afternoon!
MARIBELL:	Indeed!
(Both sisters gather i in little files.)	up the papers on the table and place them neatly

ELIZABETH:	Well sister, looks like we've reported to the government for another year.
MARIBELL:	<i>(leaning over to see ELIZABETH'S watch)</i> Oh my! Where has the time gone? I have a Ladies aid society meeting at church, and as president, I can't be late!
ELIZABETH:	Of course not. Oh, while you're there, dear, drop in on Pastor and tell him about Amanda.
MARIBELL:	Indeed, I will. We can't have a woman like her in a position of leadership.
ELIZABETH:	Certainly not! She has no scruples.

(*ELIZABETH tucks the files under one arm and ELIZABETH carefully places the church paper in her purse.*)

LIGHT up Pool 10

LIGHT Pool 5 Fade 50% on "Teacher's" clap

(TEACHER claps his hands. The scene freezes with ELIZABETH in mid-exit and MARIBELL still seated at the table.)

(LIGHTS come up on TEACHER and FOUND, who is confused and asks TEACHER:)

- **FOUND:** Don't they like Amanda, Teacher?
- TEACHER: No.
- **FOUND:** Why? What has she... Oh, Teacher, I've seen those women before. They are a part of the body, aren't they?
- TEACHER: Yes.
- FOUND: And Amanda is not, so they don't like her, right?
- **TEACHER:** No, Amanda is also a part of the body.
- **FOUND:** Then why don't they, I mean how can they.... Why did you show me this? How can this please God?
- **TEACHER:** If anyone thinks himself religious, and yet does not bridle his tongue, but deceives his own heart, this man's religion is worthless.
- **FOUND:** Then, are they not really pleasing God?
- **TEACHER:** No, not in the least.
- **FOUND:** Then why did you show me this?
- **TEACHER:** Prove yourselves doers of the word and not merely hearers who delude themselves.
- **FOUND:** So, are they deluded?
- **TEACHER:** Quite, but watch. (*Teacher prepares to clap his hands again.*)
- **FOUND:** What are you going to do?
- **TEACHER**: Something we wish we could all do! Watch.

LIGHT Pool 10 Stays 100%

LIGHT up Pool 5 100% on "Teacher's" clap

(TEACHER claps his hands again, and the sisters completely re-wind their scene, doing all their stage blocking backwards:

-- They walk backwards, unseal envelopes, hand each other things with motions done from back to front.

-- They must very carefully observe their blocking during the scene in order to do it backwards. It must be done in short jerky motions, much like a fast movie.

-- Their heads must bob, expressions must change, and the scene must end with them exiting the scene in the exact position from which they entered it.

-- This takes careful practice, but it is charming and positively hilarious!

When they finish their backwards re-wind, (it only takes about 30 seconds. Time it to the length of the song) Teacher claps his hands and the scene freezes. Essentially, he has re-wound the scene and the sisters respond to his command. He claps his hands a third time, and the scene begins again. LIGHTS out on TEACHER and FOUND in the audience.)

(NOTE: During this "Re-wind Scene" two important things happen: 1.) This is when FOUND switches her name bib in the dark.

She takes off the one she has been wearing and replaces it with the one that is under her chair. The new one reads FOUND on one side and TEACHER on the other. It is made with white letters on black felt, just like the one she has had on thus far in the show. Be sure the lettering matches, so the audience does not know that a switch has been made.

2.) TEACHER and FOUND inconspicuously move from the platform in the audience to the stairs at DL.)



MUSIC STOPS ABRUPTLY AS EVANGELIST AND SINGERS FREEZE IN TABLEAU

LIGHT up Pool 7

(SINGERS and EVANGELIST FREEZE, like mannequins. FOUND is in awe of EVANGELIST and steps up on the stage to admire him; then, she returns to downstage left where TEACHER is waiting.)

FOUND: How beautiful they sound! *(looking up) God*, look! Aren't they lovely? Oh teacher, this must be what pleases God the most, isn't it? **TEACHER:** To come before Him with joyful singing?

FOUND: Yes, and the preaching, too! Look at those eyes, Teacher! Did you see those people *looking at Him?

• MUSIC TRACK #42: "Rock of Ages - End"

(FOUND looks at them. They come to life again on stage.)

EVANGELIST: At the name of Jesus, every knee should bow, and every tongue confess, that Jesus Christ is Lord to the glory of God, the Father! Won't you confess Him now, as your Lord and Savior?

© SINGERS: JESUS! HE IS MY ROCK! JESUS! HE IS MY ROCK! JESUS!

MUSIC: BIG INSTRUMENTAL AD LIB

© SINGERS: YEAH.

(EVANGELIST and the singers FREEZE again.

FOUND leaps up from the stairs with excitement, runs up to the MUSIC ENSEMBLE and EVANGELIST, then turns to TEACHER, who rises with her.)

FOUND: Teacher, nothing could ever please God more than this! Look at them; they must be so proud of themselves, standing up there with everybody watching! This is how I want to please God; I want to be famous, too. Are you famous, teacher?

LIGHT Pools 3, 6, 7 Fade to Black LIGHT Pool 9 Stays 100%

(This question frustrates TEACHER.)

TEACHER: We have been approved by God, to be entrusted with the Gospel, so we speak, not as pleasing men, but God who examines our hearts!

LIGHT up Pool 8

(TEACHER walks from the downstage left of the stage, across the front of the audience, and toward the downstage right side of the stage. This provides a dark stage for FINAL LOST to enter onto, unnoticed by the audience, while their attention follows TEACHER.)

FOUND: (Embarrassed and hanging her head) *I'm sorry. I didn't mean ...

LIGHT Pool 9 Fade to Black

(LIGHTS fade out as FOUND follows TEACHER across to DR. She speaks in the dark, and arrives at DR to continue her conversation with TEACHER.)

• MUSIC TRACK #43: "Look At Me – Something Great"

INSTR. MUSIC D/U

FOUND: I just thought that public ministry must be very exciting. I could just imagine God looking down and being so impressed!

FOUND: (*Singing*)

IS THERE SOMETHING THAT I'M OVERLOOKING? SOMETHING GREAT, MORE IMPRESSIVE, MORE GRAND? JUST ONE THING I CAN DO THAT'S SO PRECIOUS TO YOU, YOU'LL BE PROUD TO CALL ME YOUR CHILD?

INSTR. MUSIC D/U

(TEACHER takes FOUND by the hand and starts to step onto the stage but FOUND hesitates.)

TEACHER: Come, we have further to go.

- **FOUND:** What?
- **TEACHER:** We have further to go.
- FOUND: Why?
- **TEACHER:** Don't you remember, we are journeying on the path along which there are many acts of glory?

	FOUND:	But, teacher, surely, we have found the end! What could be greater than speaking to all these people?

(FINAL LOST sits hunched over at center stage. He wears the hideous mask that FOUND wore in the first scene. He is withdrawn and afraid as TEACHER and FOUND approach the stage. TEACHER sees him instantly, but FOUND completely ignores him. LIGHTS ARE COOL AND DIM as they approach the figure of FINAL LOST.)

LIGHT Pool 8 Fade to Black

FOUND: Why are we stopping here?

TEACHER: Because there's more.

• MUSIC TRACK #44: "I Once Was Lost"

INSTR. MUSIC D/U:"I once was lost ..."

(TEACHER points to the FINAL LOST but FOUND seems to look right past him.)

FOUND: *(tugging at his sleeve) So*, let's get going! I want to see what pleases God the most!

TEACHER: Then open your eyes.

O SINGERS: *WAS BLIND, BUT NOW I SEE.*

(FOUND looks around the stage in wonder. She peeks here and there, searching for what TEACHER might be meaning. She walks around FINAL LOST but does not see him.)

- **FOUND:** Show me, Teacher. I've been waiting such a long time! I can't imagine what would be more glorious than public ministry. Show me, please, show me!
- **TEACHER:** I have shown you.

FOUND:Don't tease me, teacher!I've come a long way on this journey.I Love God, and I want to show Him how much.

TEACHER: If someone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for the one who does not love his brother whom he has seen, cannot love God whom he has not seen.

- FOUND: Teacher, you're confusing me! There's no one here.
- **TEACHER:** The field is white unto the harvest, but the laborers are few.

(FOUND finally sees LOST as she looks around the stage in front of her. She approaches LOST and looks at his ugly face. She backs away from him and toward her teacher.)

- FOUND: Teacher, you don't mean this...
- **TEACHER:** As much as you have done it for the least of these, you have done it for me.
- **FOUND:** But Teacher, this is just an ordinary person!
- **TEACHER:** There are no ordinary people! Each one of us will live forever, in the castles of Heaven or in the pits of Hell.

(FOUND studies LOST. She looks from Him to her teacher. At last Teacher confronts FOUND with her ultimate choice.)

- **TEACHER:** Each day we are helping each other to dress for Heaven or to dress for Hell. The choice is yours, Found. Will you help him?
- **FOUND:** But Teacher, I want to please the Lord, not this man! I want to love the Lord with all my heart, my strength, and my mind....

TEACHER: Then, love your neighbor as yourself.

FOUND: But he's Lost!

TEACHER: You were Lost, but now you're Found.

(FOUND takes another look at the LOST man, then comes closer to TEACHER and says in a hoarse whisper)

FOUND: Did you see his face? He's ugly.
TEACHER: (also whispering, as if keep a secret) That's not his real face; it's a mask.
FOUND: Why would he wear something so ugly?
TEACHER: I don't know; why did *you?

• MUSIC TRACK #45: "Found and Choir"

INSTR. MUSIC D/U:"I once was lost but now am found,"

FOUND:	(Taking time to reflect, realizing that she wore one, too)
	I did? I looked like *that?

(TEACHER nods, then begins to leave her on the stage with LOST. She panics and begs him to stay.)

FOUND: But Teacher, I don't know enough! I'm not as wise as you! I'm not a teacher.

(TEACHER reaches over and turns FOUND's name bib around to read: TEACHER.)

TEACHER: You who teach another, do you not teach yourself?

INSTR. MUSIC D/U: "was blind, but now I see."

FOUND: But I can't remember it all!

INSTR. MUSIC D/U:Segue into "Look at Me (Chorus – Striving Theme)

TEACHER: The helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send, He will teach you all things, and bring to mind all that has been said to you.

(TEACHER walks out of the pool of light to Upstage Left, where he lingers to observe unnoticed, while FOUND turns to find herself alone

with LOST. FOUND is pantomimes coming to grips with her responsibility for LOST as the SINGERS sing their chorus.)

SINGERS: HE DOESN'T WANT ALL YOUR STRIVING, HE ONLY LOOKS FOR ONE THING: HEART, MIND, AND SOUL GIVEN ALL TO HIS SON, LOVING YOUR NEIGHBORS TO HIM, ONE BY ONE, LEAVING AMBITION TO TAKE UP YOUR CROSS IN HIS NAME.

(Above section is repeated by SINGERS as FOUND takes the lead with a counter-melody:)

SINGERS:

He doesn't want all your striving; He only looks for one thing: Heart, mind and soul given all to His Son, Loving your neighbor to Him one by one, Leaving ambition (with FOUND) to take up your cross. (Choir stop.)

FOUND (Singing):

I DON'T KNOW IF I CAN BE ALL THAT HE WANTS ME TO BE. HE TOOK MY HAND, HE GAVE ME COURAGE TO STAND AND (with CHOIR) TO TAKE UP MY CROSS

(FOUND continues as solo)

WHEN HE SAID, "LOOK AT ME, CHILD, LOOK AT ME." "LOOK AT ME, CHILD, LOOK AT ME."

(As the song ends, she approaches LOST, who turns to face her.)

FOUND: (Looking at LOST closely.) Oh, you look awful!

LIGHT up Pool 6 to 25%

(LOST recoils and turns away from FOUND.)

I'm sorry. I shouldn't start that way. *(She turns away.)* Oh, I can't do this!

God, look! I mean, God ... help!

- LOST: Leave me alone!
- **FOUND:** I can't do that.
- **LOST:** Why not?

FOUND:	Because this is the end of my journey.	
LOST:	Then, go away.	
FOUND:	I can't do that either	
LOST:	Why not?	
FOUND:	Because I want to please God. I want to say to Him "God, look! I've done this because I love you." (<i>Defeated and frustrated</i>) God, look! I don't know what to do.	

(FOUND begins to exit in the direction of TEACHER, who raises his hand to stop her as LOST asks:)

LOST:	Who is God?
FOUND:	What?
LOST:	Who is God?
FOUND:	God? <i>(approaching him cautiously)</i> God has come to take away the ugliness of the world.
LOST:	Why?
FOUND:	Because He made us to be beautiful. We are made in His image, and He is beautiful!
LOST:	I am not beautiful.
FOUND:	You're right about that!
LOST:	I cannot know God.
FOUND:	<i>(realizing that she has hurt his feelings)</i> Oh no! Oh, I'm sorry. You see, I'm new at this. I've never been a teacher before. You can know God, you really can!
LOST:	But I am Lost!
FOUND:	Oh, I know that! I used to be Lost, too! (She carefully comes closer.) Layers of sin have made you lost. Now you're hiding behind that ugly mask; (hopefully) But it's not the real you; God made you to be beautiful! (pause) I can help you tear it off.

It's too *heavy for you to wear anymore. Believe me; I know. Let me help *you.

FOUND: My name is Found.

(FOUND extends her hand, as if to meet him for the first time.)

- **LOST:** *(Turning to FOUND, reads her name bib)* Your name is Teacher.
- FOUND: No, you see, I was Lost, and now I'm Found and--
- **LOST:** Now you're teacher.

LIGHT Pool 2 up to 30%

(TEACHER stands as light illuminates him, eagerly awaiting FOUNDS discovery.)

INST. MUSIC STOPS ABRUPTLY

(FOUND stares at her own name bib, reluctantly realizing that she really has become a teacher.)

FOUND: (*Waiting for music to stop.*) I am...I am teacher.

(TEACHER nods with approval and satisfaction. FOUND reaches out and turns over LOST's name bib, as well.)

Suggested Sermon Outline

LIGHT up Pool 6 plus pastor spotlight, if available

NOTE:

The person who played teacher can easily do the sermon since the persona of "Teacher" has already been established in him; however, the pastor of the church or the pastor in charge of the event can also present these closing thoughts.

Use of scripture:

Any of the scriptures used in this play can be expounded upon; especially if the sermon restates selected scriptures by scene.

Outline:

I.	Hold up the Mask State the gospel message and address those who are "Lost" in the audience.
II.	Hold up the "Found" Name Tag Encourage people to grow in their faith and <u>not</u> become stuck in the simple stages of it like "The Stilts Scene" or "Outward Show."
111.	Hold up the "Teacher" Name Tag Encourage those who are "Found" to move on in their faith journey to become "Teachers" themselves and not to ignore the "Lost" people all around them.
IV.	Invitation Option All three categories of the above people could be invited to come forward for prayer.




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
